Approval of Minutes:

Council reviewed the minutes from March 10th, 2025 Council Meeting. Motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the meeting minutes.

Council reviewed the minutes from March 26th, 2025 Special Meeting regarding the authorization of the sale of property. Motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the meeting minutes.

Council reviewed the minutes from April 14th, 2025 Special Meeting regarding the call committee's recommendation for a pastor. Minutes were amended, then motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the meeting minutes.

A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the current agenda for April14th, 2025.

Pastor Ted Report:

Pastor Ted talked with the council members about their role during the call process. He also confirmed notes and information he will have prepared to assist the next pastor.

Staff Reports:

A. Amanda's office report was reviewed by members of the council.

Treasurer's Reports:

A. Jerold's treasurer report was reviewed by the council. Overall, February revenue and expenses came in below budget; he is working with Amanda to get postcards send out with scannable QR codes for easier online giving from home.

- B. A finance committee has been formed: Erin Carlson, Kim Koepp, Olivia Jeurissen, Monica Bratsch, and Jerold.
- C. Katie Klaverkamp as agreed to join the audit committee.

Transfers:

Ongoing Business:

- A. Call committee update: the call committee has selected a pastoral candidate. This candidate was reviewed with the council and as unanimously approved the call committee's recommendation. On Sunday, May 4th, the congregation will formally meet, the call committee will present their recommendation , and the congregation will vote.
- B. Property task force update: The parsonage has been sold and the mortgage of the Hayden house has been paid off. They are currently seeking bids from surveying companies to formally combine the 3 lots into 1 large lot.
- C. May 4th congregation party is being planned with help from many of the teams of the church.
- D. The new finance committee has been established. Please see treasurer's note above.
- E. We will have 1-2 chaperones attending camp Onomia in June. The pastor from Henderson will also be attending.
- F. The council reviewed the Church Communication Coordinator job description. The position holds many responsibilities and we are grateful to Amanda for working to keep our church running smoothly.
- G. A motion was made, seconded and carried to table the usage rates for facilities until next month when there is a formal document to review and discuss.

- H. In early May, the building and grounds committee will be replacing the office carpeting, painting, and updating the face of the desk. The screens in the sanctuary will also be replaced.
- I. The council reviewed the resignation of Anne Herrmann and accepted electronically to attempt to fill the vacancy. We are still looking for a new council member to fill this seat through January 2027.

New Business

- A. A business expo for Belle Plaine will be held in late April. While it is too late to pursue for this year, we will make a note for next year so we can be prepared to represent St. John in the community.
- B. A motion was made, seconded and carried to update the Church Directory
- C. Mike Nagel will work on putting together a Twins game outing for members of the congregation. With council support, he will get more details for us.
- D. In ELCA youth ministries, the Lutheran Youth Organization (LYO) is for youth in the congregation. They could establish their own roles/leadership within LYO and work with the council as well as plan their own activities. Anyone interested in joining can reach out to a member of the council with hopes of having a LYO established by fall.
- E. A mutual ministry team will be created once we have a new pastor. This team will be made up of call committee, council and congregational members. More details of this team will be established once a pastoral call has been accepted.

Ministry Team Updates:

- A. Children, youth and families team has been working hard to finish out the year, plan VBS, and get a 2025-2026 calendar established.
- B. The building, ground and technology team's report was reviewed with many improvements coming.
- C. The stewardship committee will be reviewed in May

Lastly, we would like to thank Pastor Ted for all of his work and contributions to St. John in his time here!!

Motion was made, seconded, and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:08p.m. Meeting was adjourned and closed with the Lord's prayer.


