August 12th, 2025

President Jim Eggers called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m. Pastor Sherri led us in a devotion on mosaics. They are all different, unique pieces and when they come together, its great! Similarly, all members of the council are bringing different views to work together for something great - St. John Church!

### **Approval of Minutes & Agenda:**

Council reviewed the minutes from the July  $8\,\mathrm{th}$ ,  $2025\,\mathrm{Council}$  Meeting. Motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the meeting minutes.

A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the current agenda for August 12 th, 2025.

### **Staff Report:**

- **A**. Amanda's office report was reviewed by members of the council; July was busy with BBQ Days, VBS, compiling a history of St. John and getting ready for a church directory.
- **B.** Pastor Sherri's report was also reviewed. She has been visiting members, meeting the other clergy in Belle Plaine and conducting worship at Kingsway. It was also discussed that we would look into a screen to hang from the balcony for those at the altar to see while they face the congregation. This would help Pastor Sherri and service helpers to know what the congregation is viewing on the screens.

### **Treasurer's Report:**

**A.** Jerold's treasurer report was reviewed by the council. For the month of July we met our Budgeted Offering Revenue. For the year we currently short \$2,150 for the year. Compared to last year we ahead of what was given. The monthly expenses were over budget; but revenues still exceeded expenses by \$700 for the month.

**B.** Balances in accounts as of July 4th are as follows:

- a. Ameriprise Account (Stier) balance: \$115,991
- b. Property Improvement (Savings) balance: \$56,581 (plus a \$75,000 CD)
- c. Technology Fund balance: \$1,242
- d. Foundation Account (Interest from Foundation Investment) balance: \$22,653
- e. General Fund balance: \$12,600
- f. Youth Account balance: \$21,891
- g. Building Fund Checkbook balance: \$7,219
- h. Memorial Fund balance: \$19,456.74
- i. Jackson Account (Larry Kiewel) balance: \$72,182
- j. St. John Foundation Investment balance: \$181,897
- **C.** A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve Treasurer, Jerold Stauffacher, and Council President, Jim Eggers, as the authorized checking account signers. A motion was also made, seconded and carried to get Pastor Sherri a debit card to use if needed.

### **Transfers:**

No transfers this month.

### **Ongoing Business:**

**A.** The MN Twins game has 30 people signed up to attend.

**B.** Sara Bungarden spoke with the council about Rally Sunday. The Theme for the year will be "God's Work, Our Hands" and she would like to have service projects/activities for the congregation to participate in. Her recommendation for Rally Sunday: 9am Service, 10am "God's Work, Our Hands" activities and coffee hour. It was previously planned at the All Committee meeting that we would have Sloppy joes and yard games at 11am and that could remain as planned. Teacher Installation would be September 14th with the start of the fall schedule and Sunday School. The council made a motion, seconded, and carried to approve the Rally Sunday schedule that was proposed.

**C.** Universal Church Directory will be here October 9-11 and October 14-18. Please mark your calendars! They have confirmed there will be "no pressure" for additional sales. Volunteers will be needed to help with scheduling appointments and help with check-ins on picture day. Please keep an eye out for further communication.

**D**. An All Committee meeting was held on July 28th. Several groups talked of the work they are doing, and all other highlights have been covered in other agenda items.

### **New Business:**

**A.** Havyn Moonen has been collecting book donations for the last several years and delivering them to Children's Hospital and HCMC. She will be attending college in the fall and the Girl Scouts will assist her in these efforts going forward. She asked the council for permission to have a book drop box at the church. The council made a motion, seconded and carried to approve a drop box for book donations. If you have books to donate, please consider dropping them at church for this cause.

**B.** The Women's ELCA group is planning a Polka Service for May 3rd, 2026. Mark your calendars! **C.** Next Years Mission trip will be to South Dakota. All teens who would like to remain active in church through mission trips, activities and projects are encouraged to meet the First Wednesday of the month.

**D.** The Stewardship Committee met and are discussing pledge cards to be able to anticipate revenues and establish a better budget for our church.

### **Ministry Team Updates:**

**A.** The council reviewed the Worship and Music Committee report. They met on July 22nd to introduce themselves to Pastor Sherri and discussed ideas and goals for upcoming services.

Motion was made, seconded, and carried to adjourn the meeting at 7:44p.m. We closed with the Lord's Prayer.




